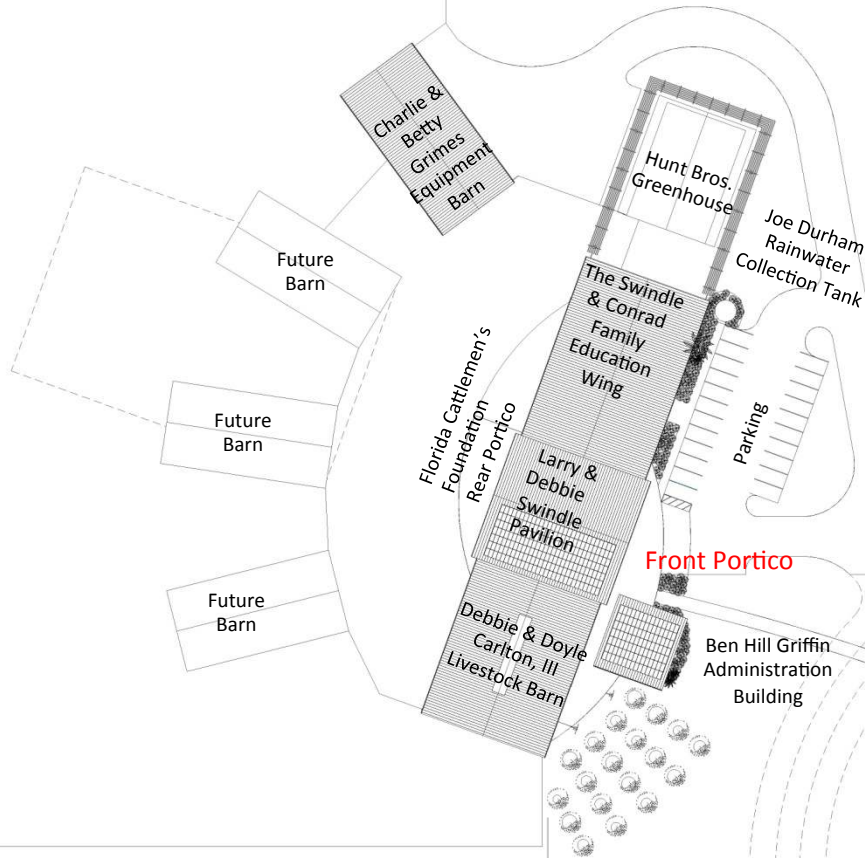




## Ed & Myrtle Lou Swindle Agriculture Complex – Warner University

The Ed & Myrtle Lou Swindle Agriculture Complex will be constructed utilizing environmentally friendly building practices. Some of the sustainable green building systems included in the Swindle Agriculture Complex will be wind mills and solar panels to be as energy self-sufficient as possible. A rainwater collection tank will provide water for irrigation and feeding purposes. This 38,000 sq. ft., \$2.8 million dollar complex was designed to enhance hands-on learning in order to graduate students skilled and ready to enter the Ag workforce. The complex was designed by Architect Scott Crews, and Ed Locke of Semco Construction will initiate the building phase once all funds have been raised, which will be in 2016.

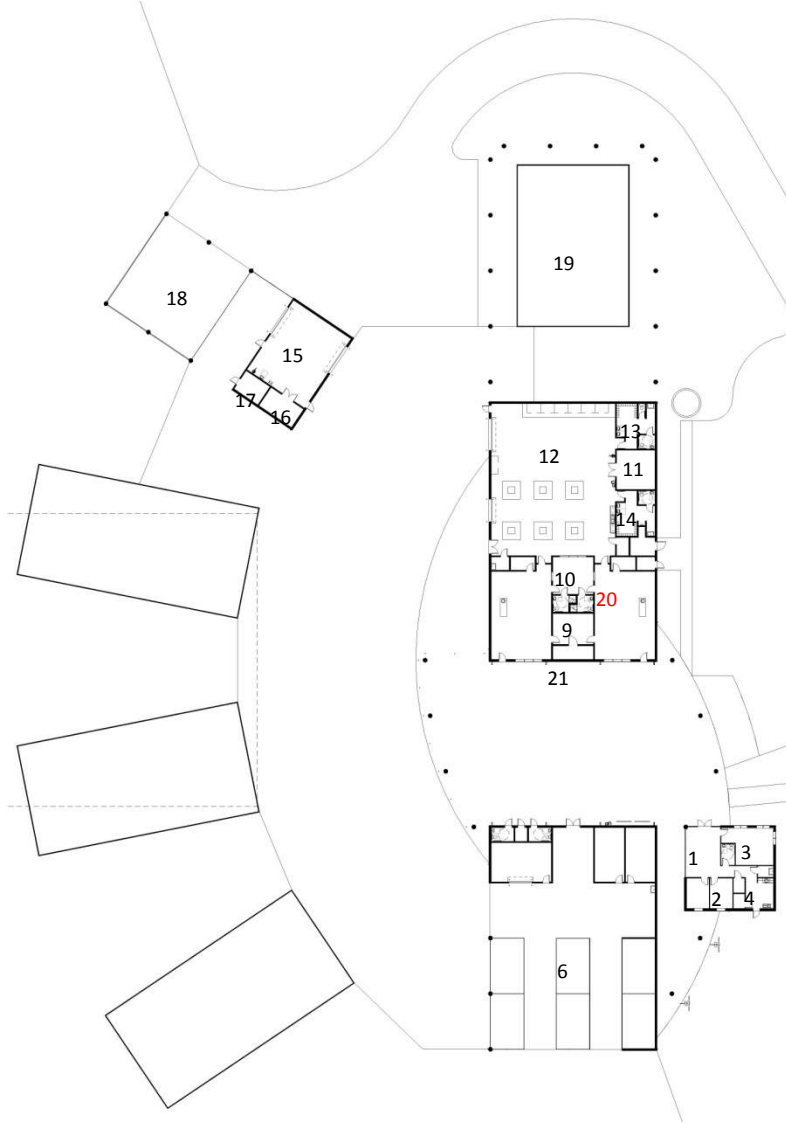

### **Ben Hill Griffin, Inc. Administration Building**
