PARKING AND DRIVING POLICY

This policy is in place to facilitate the work of University personnel, and students through parking control and movement of motor vehicles while on campus.

All vehicles operated on the campus of Warner University by students, faculty and staff MUST BE REGISTERED with Campus Safety and Security within 10 days of such use. Regulations are in effect and enforced throughout the academic year (August - July). This is at no charge to the student. By registering your vehicle with Campus Safety and Security you are agreeing to drive and a safe and sensible manner at all times. Obeying the campus speed limit and driving the proper way on designated roads and parking areas is a must.

Vehicle permits are registered to one person and are not transferable to another person. Only one permit will be issued at any one time to a student. Please report the loss or theft of a permit immediately in order for a replacement to be issued.

The vehicle permit is to be placed on the rear window at the bottom corner of the left (drivers) side. The responsibility of finding a legal parking space rests with the motor vehicle operator. Registrants **are not guaranteed** a parking space near their Residence Hall, work or recreational activities.

Do not stop or park in the following areas:

Fire Lanes per Florida State Statue these must remain clear for emergency vehicles.

Within 15ft. of a fire hydrant per Florida State Statue 316.1945

Handicapped parking spaces per Florida State Statue 316.1959

On any sidewalk or bicycle path

Median grass areas on any roads (i.e.: Presidents Drive at South Lake Wales Church of God).

Any place marked with "No Parking" signs or barrier tape.

Any painted areas, curbed or other areas where the marking would prohibit parking. (i.e. the area behind Fulton and Raines).

New Parking areas

- Fulton and Raines Parking lot, there is no parking on the East side of the entrance/exit road and Fire Lanes.
- Cleary Center, no parking in the grass in front of the Cleary Center
- Pond side parking, you may park in the grass on the west side of the pond, but not on the PLRC/Rigel Center side.

An emergency situation can arise in a moments notice. For this reason we must keep all fire lanes clear of parked or stopped vehicles. Vehicles parked in these areas may be towed at the owners expense.
