The Course Schedule has been published online and has included classes for all the academic environments of Warner in one listing. The traditional, non-traditional, and graduate programs are included in this publication. A few instructions will help you with the registration process:

Traditional students (those in the Monday through Friday, daytime courses on campus) will work to find courses in the traditional listings. Academic advisors will direct traditional students to register for traditional classes. Any exceptions will need a written rationale for a traditional student registering for a non-traditional class. Any exceptions must have the approval of the appropriate Dean.

Non-Traditional students (those in evening programs, either in the accelerated 8-week format, on campus or online, or the accelerated 4-week format, on campus or online) will work to find courses in the non-traditional listings. You may choose courses from the traditional listings, but remember, you will need to meet the classes as they are scheduled during the day.

Graduate students, in the three graduate degree programs, will work to find course listings in the graduate section. You will follow the same procedure for registering as you have experienced in your program with past registrations.

Any undergraduate student request for scheduling an overload (19 or more hours) must have a written rationale and be approved by the CAO. All programs of study, traditional and non-traditional, must follow this procedure for an overload of credits.

Any undergraduate student request for scheduling must respect prerequisites. If a situation arises to consider an exception, the division chair and the Dean will need to provide approval.

Registration forms must be completed, in full, by the advisor. No registration form will be accepted by the Registrar with corrections and/or changes. If a course is closed, only a Dean, or the Registrar, may make a correction to a registration form. The Registrar has the final say as to the validity of a registration form.

No two classes can be scheduled at the same time. No exceptions.

No lab can be scheduled at the same time as a class. No exceptions.

Questions about registering should be directed to your academic advisor.
