

Commencement Walk Policy

Commencement celebrates the accomplishments of students who have successfully completed all degree requirements. "Walking" is the term used to indicate participation in commencement exercises; though walking in Warner University Commencement exercises does not indicate degree completion or a guarantee thereof.



Permission to Walk

Undergraduate and graduate students who have completed all degree requirements have permission to walk in the commencement ceremony and do not need to appeal to walk.

Undergraduate students may appeal to walk if they are within nine (9) hours of degree completion and have proof of registration for the missing nine hours in either the summer or fall terms.

Graduate students may appeal to walk if they are within six (6) hours of degree completion and have proof of registration for the missing six hours in either the summer or fall terms.

Deadline to Appeal

The appeal to walk is required by February 15.

Provide proof of registration for summer and/or fall enrollment no later than 7 days before commencement.
