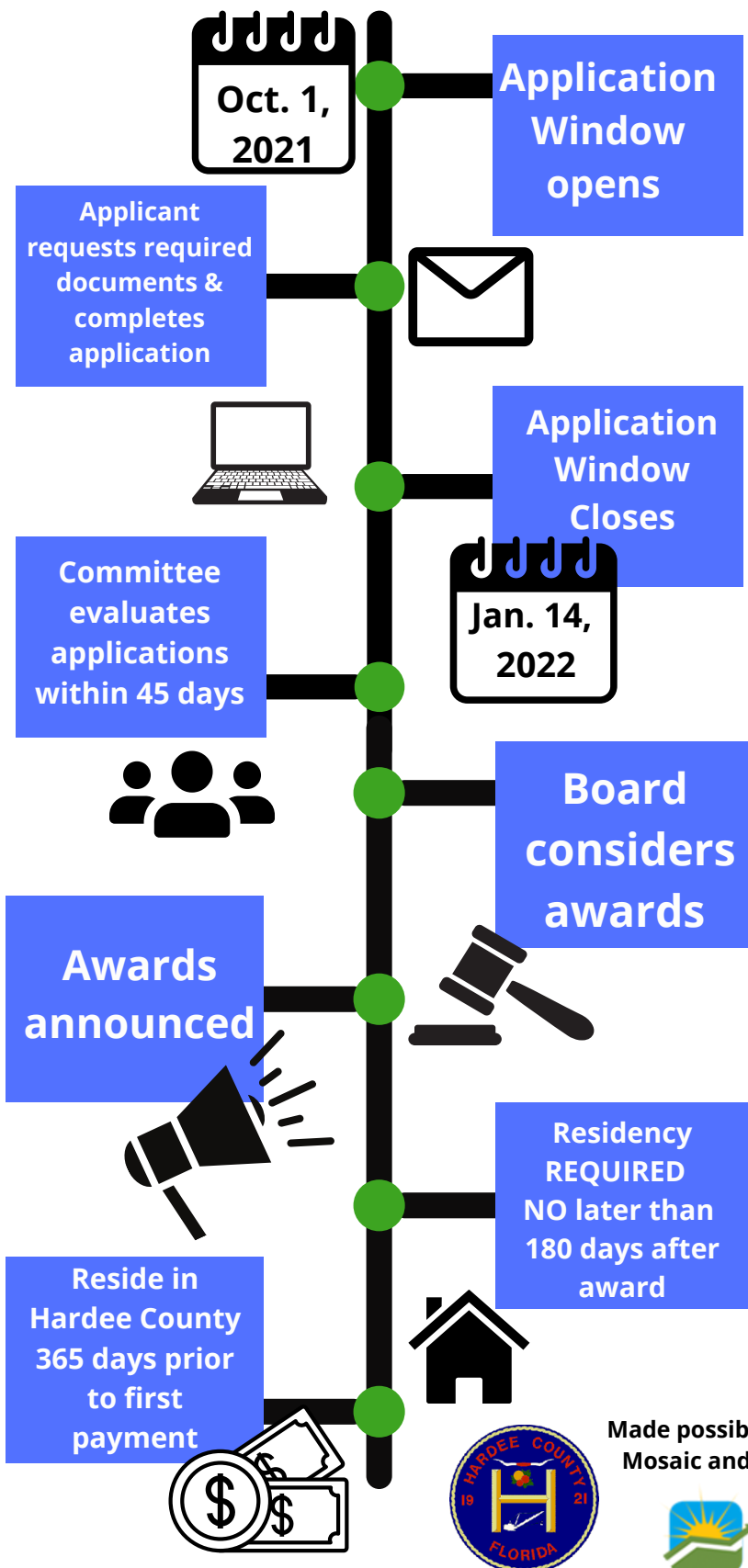


2021 Grow Hardee Scholarship

The Grow Hardee Scholarship is designed to be a reverse scholarship which incentivizes individuals with undergraduate college degree(s) or post-secondary trade, technical, vocational, or industry certification(s) to live in Hardee County, Florida.



Who is Eligible?

- Individuals who received a Post-Secondary Trade, Technical, Vocational, or Industry Certificate OR Undergraduate Degree in: 2018, 2019, 2020, or 2021; AND
- Agree to live in Hardee County, Florida for 5 years

How Much Scholarship Can I Receive?

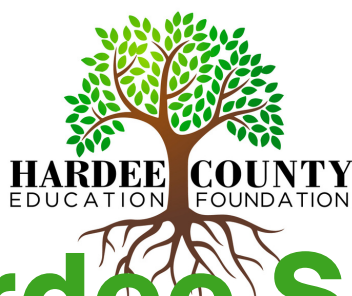
- Up to ALL of the Tuition and Fees that were incurred during your degree or certificate attainment minus any previous scholarships or grants

When do I Receive the Scholarship Funds?

- Reside in Hardee County for 365 days prior to the first payment;
- 5 equal annual installments if Hardee County residency is maintained for 5 consecutive years following the award

Oct. 1, 2021-Jan. 14, 2022**

Request Official Documents

- Official Transcripts from your undergraduate or post-secondary trade, technical, or vocational school
- Official Detailed Bill of Payment History

Request that these documents be mailed* or transmitted directly to the Hardee County School District, C/O Hardee County Education Foundation.

Request Official Hardee County School District Transcripts, if applicable

Establish Residency in Hardee County

*Mail a copy of at least two (2) of the following documents: Lease, rental, mortgage agreement; Utility bill; Voter registration; Driver's License; or Notarized Affidavit of Residency.

Residency documents are due no later than 180 days after the scholarship award date.
